Criteria Include:

- Referral from within HPT or new clients with an OT evaluation no more than six months old. If you do not have a referral from within HPT and no current OT evaluation is available, a one hour evaluation can be performed to determine your child's needs, which includes a brief follow up consultation with parents to review findings.
- Completion of parent and teacher questionnaires.
- Group appropriateness to be determined by HPT therapists.

Fantastic Fingers (Pre-Writing Group)

- Body awareness
- Posture in preparation for writing
- Crossing midline, trunk rotation, and bilateral coordination
- Finger dexterity and strength
- Spatial concepts and line strokes needed for writing letters
- Development of a functional writing grasp
- Eye-hand coordination
- Developmentally appropriate self-care skills
- Scissors Skills
- Letter identification

Preliminary Printers (Beginning printing group: Pre-K to K)

- Capital and lowercase letter formation through fun, engaging activities
- Whole-body movement and music to inspire learning
- Pre-reading skills
- Body awareness
- Fine motor skills

Power Printers (Advanced printing group: Grades 1 & 2)

Skills 1-8 as in Fantastic Fingers and skills in Preliminary Printers, plus:

- Perfecting legibility
- Perfecting letter line placement on a variety of writing contexts (lined papers, fill in the blanks, etc.) and while copying from the chalkboard
- Perfecting spacing between letters and words
- Perfecting writing speed
- Integrating creative writing techniques, with use of graphic organizers & writing prompts, while maintaining legibility of writing

I Can Do Cursive I (Beginning cursive group: Grade 2-4+)

- Kinesthetic awareness
- Identification of upper and lowercase cursive letters
- Formation of strokes for individual capital and lowercase letters
- Line orientation of letters
- Connections between letters

I Can Do Cursive II (Advanced cursive group: Grade 4+)

- Perfecting letter line placement on a variety of writing contexts (lined papers, fill in the blanks, etc.) and while copying from the chalkboard
- Perfecting spacing between letters and words
- Perfecting writing speed
- Integrating creative writing techniques, with use of graphic organizers & writing prompts, while maintaining legibility of writing

Keyboarding Kids

- Isolation of keys for touch typing on QWERTY keyboard
- Speed and accuracy training
